

# Brian's Notes regarding the 1971 recording of Distant Places

Unfortunately, due to long lost take sheets and the difficulty inherent in recalling all the many details of recording sessions\* that took place more than 50 years ago, I regret not being able to share complete information about all the personnel on those sessions—specifically, the electric bass player and the keyboardist on the Steinway Grand. However, and as credited more fully at <a href="www.brianpenrycom">www.brianpenrycom</a>, here are pertinent details on the other personnel who accompanied me on *Distant Places:* 

John Kalishes - Electric Lead Guitar (John also co-produced those early sessions with me)

Lou Cassella – Pedal Steel Guitar & Principal Recording Enginner

Jimmy Hodder - Drums

I did the original vocal tracks and played acoustic guitar on those original sessions. Late in 2023, I re-recorded my vocals accompanied by **Heather Joseph** on backing vocals.

\*Recorded at (now defunct) Natural Sound, Maynard, MA—where Jonathan Edwards, Orpheus and others recorded hit records. We recorded on an 8-track Scully tape machine and a control board that once belonged to James Brown.
